- ▶ Due to budget cuts we might **NOT** have certain programs so make sure you list alternate classes

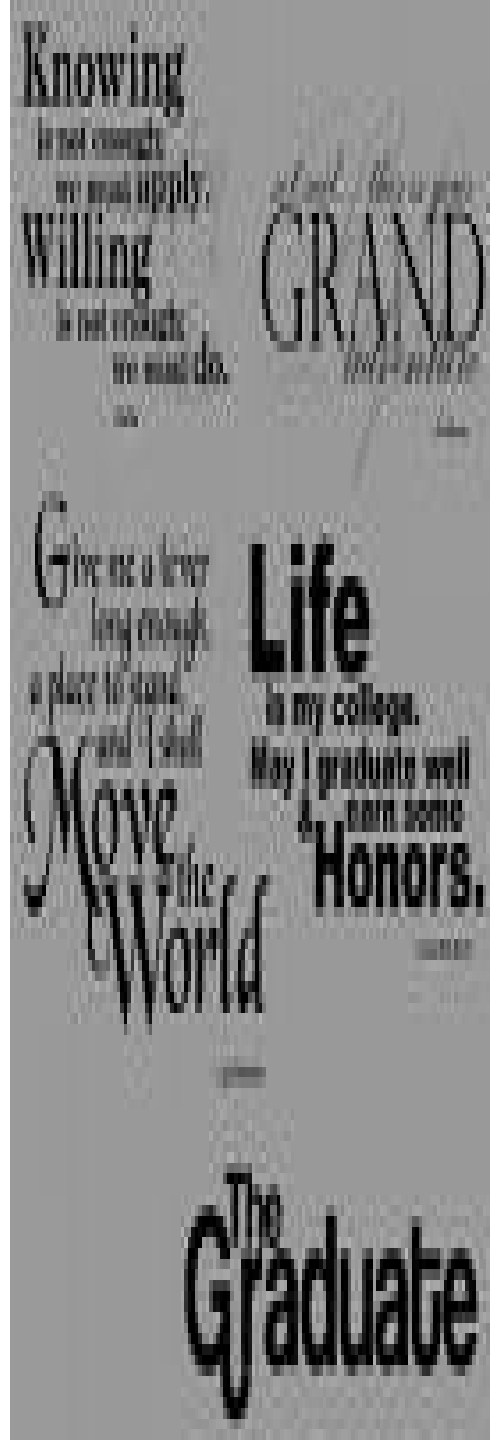


Graduation Requirements


- ▶ All students need to complete 220 credits and pass the CAHSEE to receive a diploma!



40 CREDITS	ENGLISH
20 CREDITS	MATH (MUST INCLUDE ALGEBRA 1 AND GEOMETRY)
30 CREDITS	SCIENCE (MUST INCLUDE 1 LIFE, 1 PHYSICAL AND 1 MORE OF EITHER)
30 CREDITS	SOCIAL SCIENCE (WORLD HIST, U.S. HISTORY, GOV/ECON)
20 CREDITS	PE (4 YEARS OF ROTC OR BAND CAN MEET THE REQUIREMENT)
10 CREDITS	FOREIGN LANG OR VISUAL PERFORMING ARTS
70 CREDITS	ELECTIVES
CAHSEE	PASS EXIT EXAM!

English

- ▶ Students need a total of 40 English Credits for Graduation
- ▶ Take the next level
- ▶ A Grade of A or B and recommendation in current English course to be recommended for AP English III or Expository English III.
- ▶ Circle the Eng Course that is your choice.

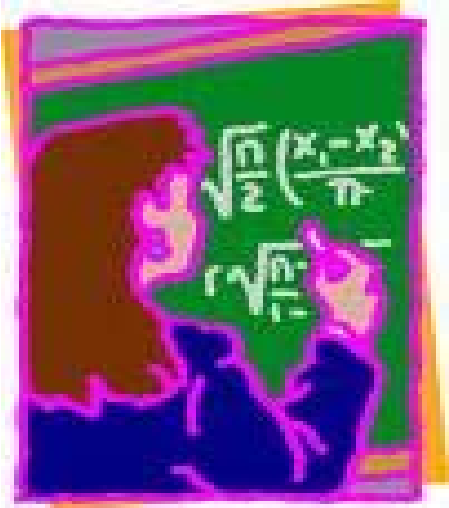


Math



- ▶ Students need a total of 20 Math Credits for graduation.
- ▶ Students need to complete Algebra 1, Algebra 1B, and Geometry or Practical Geometry for graduation.
- ▶ Counselors will place students based on 1st semester grades and discussion with students.

Math



- ▶ Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II for 4 year (UC/CSU)
- ▶ Math Analysis (need C or better in Alg II)
- ▶ Statistics AP (need C or better in Algebra II)
- ▶ Circle Appropriate Math class

•Please note: AP courses will only be offered based on student demand.

Social Science

- ▶ **Graduation Requirement:** 30 credits of Social Studies to graduate.
- ▶ Students wanting to take AP US History need English teacher recommendation.
- ▶ Circle either US History or AP US History



Science

- ▶ **Graduation Requirement: 3 years - 1 Life (Biology) 1 Physical and 1 year of Life or Physical to Graduate**
- ▶ **Minimum Biology, Chemistry or Physics for 4-Year College Bound Students (UC/CSU).**
- ▶ **Chemistry or Physics: Completion of Biology and at least concurrent enrollment in Algebra II is recommended.**
- ▶ **Anatomy and Physiology - completion of Biology with a C or better.**



Science

- ▶ **Biology AP** - completion of Biology and Chemistry with grades of C or better, (B or higher preferred) or teacher recommendation.
- ▶ **Chemistry AP** - completion of Biology and Chemistry with grades of C or better (B or higher preferred), or teacher recommendation.
- ▶ **Circle Appropriate Science class**



AP Classes will be offered based upon student demand.

Foreign Language

- ▶ Students need 1 year of Fine/Performing Arts OR Foreign Language for Graduation.
- ▶ 4-Year College Bound Students must take 2 full years of the same Foreign Language(UC/CSU)
- ▶ Take next level with teacher recommendation (grade of "C" or better)
- ▶ Spanish I - III (IV & V AP)
- ▶ Heritage Spanish I & II
- ▶ French I - III (IV AP)





Visual/Performing Arts

- ▶ Students need 1 year of Fine/Performing Arts OR Foreign Language for Graduation.

- ▶ 4-Year College Bound Students must take 1 full year of Fine/Performing Art (UC/CSU)
 - Art I - IV
 - Photography (Still waiting to be UC/CSU approved)
 - Advanced Photography (Still waiting to be UC/CSU approved)
 - Sculpture I



Visual/Performing Arts

- ▶ Band (Auditions for advanced courses)
- ▶ Vocal (Auditions for advanced courses)
- ▶ Advanced Drama or Drama Productions

- ▶ Music Appreciation

- ▶ *Summer 2010: Music Appreciation may be offered to fulfill UC/CSU Fine Art requirement”.



PE

- ▶ Two years of PE
- ▶ The PE requirement is met by:
 - Dance
 - Pageantry and Cheerleading are PE Credit
 - Athletic PE - Need Coaches Initials on Registration form and get Athletic PE Contract
 - ROTC
 - 1 year of Marching Band equals 5 PE Credits



Electives

- ▶ Choose Electives **CAREFULLY!**
- ▶ Read about them!

- ▶ Choose elective alternates
 - Not everyone will get their first choice.
 - Especially true due to budget cuts!!!

Electives

- ▶ Some Electives have shop fees (\$)
- ▶ Advanced Electives you must have a recommendation.
- ▶ ALL Electives are year long and there will be NO class changes at semester!



Off Campus ROP Courses

- ▶ **ROP Fire Technology (11th or 12th grade)**
 - At Hesperia High School, Monday and Tuesdays from 2:30-5:00PM

- ▶ **ROP Dental (12th grade-plan for next year)**
 - At Mojave High School (Alt. Center) Monday - Friday from 12:00-4:00

- ▶ **ROP Cosmetology (12th grade-plan for next year)**
 - At Mojave High School (Alt. Center) Monday - Friday from 12:00-4:00
 - Write on your form if you are interested in Fire Technology

T.A. and Office Worker

- ▶ Can only be taken IF you have passed both sections of the CAHSEE AND have a 2.0 GPA!
- ▶ Can only have either TA or Office Worker. One period only!
- ▶ Choose which office you would like or choose which subject area you would like to TA for. You will be placed with a teacher or office based on need.
- ▶ PLEASE DO NOT put specific teachers.

Late Arrival for Juniors!!

- ▶ Students who have passed the CAHSEE and have at least 120 credits at the beginning of their junior year can qualify.
- ▶ (Sophomores thinking about this option should currently have at least 90 credits).
- ▶ Students must provide transportation.
- ▶ There will be a contract that if you have too many tardies, absences or if you fail a class the privilege will be removed and you will be placed in what ever elective class that there is room!

Summer School

- ▶ Will be held at Hesperia High School
- ▶ 5 weeks 5 days/week
- ▶ Dates:
 - June 1st-June 30
- ▶ Only academic classes will be offered NO sports PE.
- ▶ No Transportation Provided!
- ▶ All Applications due by April 23rd
- ▶ **NO FIRST DAY ENROLLMENTS!!**



Summer School

- ▶ Forms will be handed out when you meet with your counselor (make sure you write "Summer School" at the top of your form)
- ▶ Tier I priority: students behind in credits
- ▶ Tier II priority: students who need class as written on ILP
- ▶ Tier III: students trying to get ahead



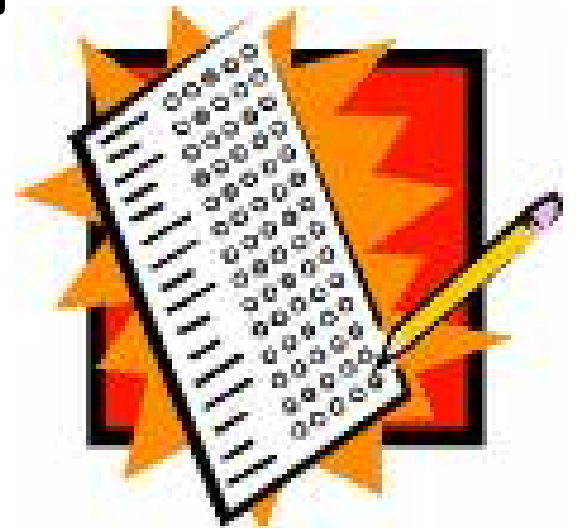
California High Exit Exam (CAHSEE)

- ▶ **Tests Language Arts and Math**
 - Given once during the Sophomore year
 - Given twice during Junior year
 - Given three times during Senior Year
- ▶ **SOPHOMORES** will be taking the test for the first time March 16 and 17th
- ▶ **Study!** Links on the OHHS web site



State Testing

- ▶ **CST Testing will be in April 12-23**
- ▶ **Rewards for scores of proficient or advanced.**
- ▶ **Important for college!! (Early Assessment Program)**
- ▶ **DO YOUR BEST!**



4 Year College Bound Students

- ▶ Please listen to your counselor about important dates!
- ▶ All college bound Juniors should be signed up for both the SAT and the ACT.
- ▶ All should be applying for at least 1 scholarship per month
- ▶ You should have your 10 colleges narrowed down to the 5 you will apply for next fall.
- ▶ UC bound students need to sign up for 2 SAT Subject tests (NOT Math 1)

Student Athletes

- ▶ All of you should have attended a NCAA workshop by now. Or you will be very soon!
 - ▶ Student Athletes need to register with NCAA Clearinghouse the summer after their junior year.
 - ▶ I will be checking for this during Ed Plans next year.
